

Franklin 8th Grade Ski Trip



- Where:** Sundown Mountain Ski Resort (West of Dubuque)
- When:** Friday, January 18th, 2019 from 8:15 A.M. to 4:45 P.M. (In the event of a school cancellation or late start, the trip will be rescheduled for January 25th.)
- Transportation:** Charter buses to and from Sundown. All students must ride to and from Sundown on the bus.
You may not ride with a parent.

Trip Packages:

\$45 for students renting ski equipment

This includes:

1. Transportation to and from Sundown
2. Rental equipment (skis, poles, gaiters and helmet)
3. Ski lift ticket
4. Ski lesson

NO SNOWBOARDING ALLOWED

\$40 for students bringing their own ski equipment

(Skis must pass inspection by Sundown)

This includes:

1. Transportation to and from Sundown
2. Ski lift ticket
3. Ski lesson

NO SNOWBOARDING ALLOWED

Other expenses:

1. Cost of lunch at Sundown, approximately \$6-\$10 OR students may bring a sack lunch.
If you would like a sack lunch to be provided for your student at the regular school lunch price, please **enter your student's ID number in the box on the next page.**
2. Storage locker at Sundown \$1 (bring quarters) or a storage basket \$2, for the whole day.

Requirements to attend the trip:

1. Signed parent permission slip **due by January 11th.** (No Exceptions unless arrangements are made)
2. Payment for trip **DUE BEFORE January 18th.** **MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO FRANKLIN MIDDLE SCHOOL**
3. Proper cold weather attire (warm coat, gloves, stocking cap, etc.) For safety reasons, students will not be allowed on the bus without gloves and stocking cap – no baseball caps.
4. Good behavior/academic history at school. Students who have exhibited inappropriate behaviors in the past may not be allowed to attend the trip.

Can parents attend?

Yes, in fact we encourage it! The cost is the same as the kids. We are limited to a certain number of seats on the buses; so unfortunately, we cannot guarantee you a seat on the bus. You may have to drive yourself or carpool with other parents. It's still the cheapest skiing you can get and a great way to see your kids in action!
