EXPECTATIONS OF BEHAVIOR

1. No running in the auditorium or jumping off the front of the stage.
Use the stairs.
2. No cell phones– same as the school policy on phones.
3. Do not leave the rehearsal space without permission.
4. Leave the rehearsal space neat and clean!
5. No food or drink in light booth, sound booth.
6. Do not disrupt the rehearsal process.
7. Keep yourself quiet and occupied while waiting for your scene to start.

If you do not meet these expectations of behavior, your parents will be called and that means you will NOT get to participate in drama.

If you break a rule you get one point. Any Adult can issue a point.

As soon as you have **3 points** your **parent will be called** to discuss the problems.

Then you will be referred to the office and you will not be able to participate in drama club.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO DO WHEN YOU ARE IN A PLAY

1. COME TO REHEARSAL ON TIME.
2. KNOW WHEN YOU ARE SCHEDULED FOR REHEARSAL.
3. BRING YOUR SCRIPT AND A SHARP PENCIL TO EVERY REHEARSAL.
4. MEMORIZE YOUR LINES ON TIME FOR OFF-BOOK REHEARSALS.
6. CREATE A CHARACTER.
7. SPEAK LOUDLY WITH CONFIDENCE.
8. RESPECT OTHERS. DO YOUR JOB AND LET THEM DO THEIRS.
9. YOU MUST BE AT ALL RUN-THRU, TECH/DRESS REHEARSALS AND PERFORMANCES. PUT THESE DATES ON YOUR CALENDAR!
10. YOU MUST MAKE REHEARSALS A PRIORITY.
If you miss too many rehearsals you will be replaced.
11. HAVE FUN, WORK HARD AND HAVE A GOOD ATTITUDE.
